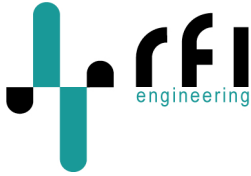

From 1999 to 2001 he was Global Head of E-Business, and responsible for ING's strategy on web-based financial services worldwide. After the purchase of Barings Bank in 1995, Jacques Kemp became a member of the Executive Committee of ING Barings. In the late 1990s, Jacques was involved in the start-up of ING Direct. Under his leadership ING acquired major stakes in banks like Bank Slaski, Poland, Bank of Beijing, China and in PayPal, the leading e-payment provider. Presently he is a non-executive



board member of various companies, including KB Financial Group, Korea. Jacques has started his own consultancy bureau ToBecome to support the strategy of multinationals.
